Title: How to Pray?

Scripture: Psalm 139

1. God alone is omniscient. (vs. 1–6)

What we think about God determines everything about us, especially how we pray.

- **GOD KNOWS YOU AND HE HAS REVEALED HIMSELF SO YOU CAN KNOW HIM.**

2. God alone is omnipresent. (vs. 7–12)

How we act when we are aware or unaware of God's presence influences how we pray.

- **There is nowhere that God will not be present to lead us or hold us.**

3. God is omnipotent. (vs. 13–18)

How we treat ourselves and others reveals what we really think about God.

- ***God doesn't make Junk! God made me! Therefore, I am not junk! I am God's marvelous creation JUST the way that I am.***

4. God is omni-patient. (vs. 19–24)

How often we repent reveals to us how we feel about God and prayer.

- **God thoroughly searches us and is immutably forgiving.**
- **The key to righteous living is not perfection - it is repentance.**

How to PRAY?

- 1. Praise**
- 2. Repent**
- 3. Ask**
- 4. Yield**
