

# Rules & Policies

1. Follow the camp schedule! (All campers must attend all activities and be ON TIME!)
2. Everyone MUST eat ALL meals! (Chaps will be monitoring this) - DRINK LOTS OF WATER!!!!!!!!!!!!
3. Except while in bed or in pool, campers must wear name tag at ALL TIMES.
4. Campers must never be alone. Campers must travel in groups of at least THREE at all times!
5. All campers must abide by all LIGHTS OUT curfews! No "sneak outs," unsupervised hikes, raids on other rooms, etc. Anyone caught outside their room without permission after "lights out" **will be sent home** at the parents expense.
6. Boys' rooms are blue. Girls' rooms are pink. There are **NO PURPLE ROOMS**. The boys' rooms are OFF LIMITS to girls and the girls' rooms are OFF LIMITS to the boys. **\*\*Campers will be sent home for any violation of this guideline with no questions asked!\*\***
7. Be respectful of campus property! Parents will be held **financially liable** for any damage to rooms/property, including broken lamps, beds, fixtures, etc.
8. Always carry your Bible and Camp Student Book to worship and small group time (we suggest a small backpack for essentials during tracks and worship).
9. **Modesty is policy!** Modest shirts for both guys and girls (NO spaghetti straps, crop tops, tank tops must not expose undergarments, etc). Shorts that DO NOT ride down to show your belly button, and must be long enough that when hands are extended to the side, finger tips must touch fabric. Absolutely NO cheer shorts (with or without writing), yoga/leggings/spandex pants are to be worn outside of the rooms. Do not dress in a way that calls attention to undergarments (sagging pants, rolling down your waistbands, off the shoulder shirts, etc.) All guys will wear their shirts at all times unless swimming or bathing. CHAPS have the right to ask you to change if your clothing is deemed inappropriate.
10. Absolutely NO electronics (this includes CELL PHONES) are to be brought to camp! If these items are brought, they will be taken and given back at the end of the week.
11. Treat each other, all adults, facilities, and yourself with respect.
12. 3 Strikes & You're OUT!
  - Strike 1: Warning by CHAP or CAMP LEADERSHIP
  - Strike 2: Sit down chat with Pastor Jonathan & parents are notified
  - Strike 3: Camper is sent home at parent's expense

# What to bring Checklist

## PLEASE LABEL ALL ITEMS WITH FIRST & LAST NAME

### Clothing:

\*Make it all fit in **ONE** piece of luggage

- Complete change of clothes for each day of the week, including appropriate clothes for tracks, worship, rec, an outfit for OMC (this will be messy)
- Pajamas/Night Clothes
- Closed toe shoes (tennis shoes for recreation and outdoor tracks)
- Flip Flops or Sandals that can get wet (for showers)
- Sweatshirt or light jacket for cool night & in buildings
- Swimsuit (modest one piece for girls and normal trunks for guys...NO SPEEDOS)
- Colored coverup or t-shirt for swimsuit/water games
- Plastic bag for dirty/wet clothes
- Light rain jacket/poncho

### Toiletries:

- Toothbrush/toothpaste
- Shampoo/Conditioner - small (best if put in plastic bags before putting in suitcase)
- Soap (bag for bar or bottle)
- DEODORANT
- Brush and/or Comb
- Hair Ties (if needed)
- WATERPROOF sunscreen (enough to last the ***whole week***)  
CHAPS will be carrying around sunscreen to the tracks to make sure kids stay well protected
- Shower Towel & Washcloth (NO LINENS are provided by camp)
- Pool Towel

- Sheet & Blanket and/or Sleeping Bag and PILLOW (NO LINENS are provided by camp)  
These can be put in a **WHITE PLASTIC** Garbage Bag labeled with **BLACK SHARPIE**

### Worship Material:

- Bible with your name printed inside
- Pen/Highlighter
- Notepad or Notebook
- Small bag or backpack - SWAG bag will be issued to each camper  
(can use same one for tracks/pool)

### Other Stuff:

- Medications - Prescription and Non-prescription  
**MUST BE turned in to MEDICATION BINS upon arrival at church MONDAY MORNING**
- Spending money  
Please separate into **THREE**, labeled envelopes: Missions Offering, Meals (to and from camp) & Spending money for coffee shop/ice cream, camp store, etc.
- Camera (optional) - \*\*\*May NOT be a phone, iPod, etc.
- Water bottle
- Small Alarm Clock (with batteries)
- 1 bottle of Silly String
- 1 bottle of Shaving Cream (not gel...the foamy stuff)
