Scripture: Hebrews 12:3-17

- 1. Believers discipline themselves for coming persecution. (v. 4)
- 2. Believers are disciplined by God as His sons and daughters. (vs. 5-11)
  - a. Discipline is a sign of sonship (vs. 5-11)
    - i. Sign of love (v. 6)
    - ii. Sign of an engaged father (vs. 7-8)
    - iii. Sign of respect (v. 9)
    - iv. Sign of growth (vs. 10-11)
- 3. Believers discipline themselves to keep on keeping on and not lose heart. (vs. 12-13)
- 4. Believers discipline themselves to pursue peace and personal holiness. (v. 14)
- 5. Believers discipline themselves to give the same grace they have received. (v. 15)
- 6. Believers discipline themselves to avoid sexual temptation and irreverence. (v. 16)
- 7. Believers discipline themselves to see the warning signs (v. 17)
