Title: True Love

Scripture: Hebrews 13:1-9

1. God defines and demonstrates love, and demands that we love one another. (v. 1)
2. True love shows hospitality. (vs. 2-3)
3. True love holds marriage in honor. (v. 4)
4. True love holds money loosely. (v. 5)
5. True love is found in Jesus. (vs. 6-9)
 - a. We learn the love of Jesus by carefully considering who to imitate. (vs. 6-8)
 - b. We keep truly loving by following sound teaching. (v. 9)
 - c. We strengthen our hearts with the grace of Jesus so we do not lose heart (v. 9)

Jesus is the same yesterday, today, and forever. (v. 8)
