CAMPER GUIDELINES TO FOLLOW

- Follow the camp schedule faithfully. Everyone must attend all activities and be ON TIME.
 - Everyone **MUST** eat at ALL meals - **DRINK PLENTY OF WATER!!!!**
 - While participating in activities and eating at meals, your camp name tag must remain **ON** at ALL TIMES.
 - All campers must abide by all crewfews and lights out times.
- NO raids on other rooms, sneak-outs, or unsupervised hikes - anyone caught out of their room without permission after "lights out" **will be sent home!**
- The boys' rooms are off limits to the girls, and the girls' rooms are off limits to the boys.
Students will be sent home for this violation of this guideline.
- Parents and students will be held **financially liable for any damage to dorm rooms,** including broken lamps, beds, or having to replace keys.
- Always bring your Bible and camp student book to worship and small group time.
- Clothe yourself modestly.
 - Wear sleeved shirts - NO tank tops, spaghetti straps, crop tops, etc.
 - Wear modest shorts (when hands are extended to the back or the front, finger tips must touch fabric) - no cheer shorts with or without writing on the backside.
 - NO Large t-shirts or sweatshirts that cover shorts.
 - NO yoga/leggings/spandex pants are allowed to be worn outside of the dorms.
 - Do not dress in a way that calls attention to underwear (sagging your pants, rolling down your waistbands, etc.).
 - All guys will wear their shirts at all times unless swimming or bathing.
 - Wear modest, one-piece bathing suits or two-piece bathing suits covered with a dark colored t-shirt, if swimming or participating in water activities.
 - Wear modest shorts, pants, jeans, or dresses for worship. Dresses with spaghetti or small straps, open backs, and excessively short lengths are unacceptable (when hands are extended to the back or the front, finger tips must touch fabric.)
 - *** Adult leaders reserve the right to ask you to change if your clothing is deemed inappropriate.***

CAMPER GUIDELINES TO FOLLOW

- iPod's, Tablets, Radios, hand-held video games, etc **are not allowed**. If these items are brought to FUGE, they will be taken and given back at the end of the week. No water balloons, shaving cream or other such material are allowed. No fireworks, firearms, knives, cherry bombs, or nuclear weapons. No tobacco, vapes, drugs, or alcohol. Also, no MORPH suits.
- NO CELL PHONES ARE ALLOWED. If a cell phone is taken to FUGE, leaders will take it until we return home. *Please see our Cell Phone Policy.*
- Treat each other, all adults, facilities, and property with respect.
 - *No public displays of affection.*
- Be in rooms by 11:00PM with lights out no later than 11:30PM.
 - NO guys in girls' rooms or hallways & NO girls in guys' rooms or hallways.
- 3 Strikes And You're OUT - When it comes to discipline, here is how we handle it:
 - Strike 1 - Warning
 - Strike 2 - Sit down talk with Pastor Mike and parents are notified
 - Strike 3 - Student is sent home at parents expense
- Anyone breaking these rules will be sent home at the expense of the parents with no refund of camp money.

THEME OVERVIEW - MATCHLESS ONE

The Bible is filled with stories of ordinary people God used in extraordinary ways to teach character and truth. Through Isaac's life, we learn about sacrifice. Joseph's life shows us the hard-fought beauty of forgiveness and reconciliation. Abraham's story teaches us about obedience and forgiveness. From Esther, we learn how to be bold and courageous and take risks. One person in Scripture is the full and complete embodiment of every good trait any other character ever displayed - Jesus. He is the MATCHLESS ONE. At FUGE Camps 2022 as we study the lives of these well-known Old Testament characters and see the story of Jesus foreshadowed in their lives.

Day 1 - Matchless Sacrifice THE GRAND NARRATIVE – ISAAC AND JESUS

Scripture: *Genesis 22:1-14, Leviticus 4:27-35, Mark 15:21-37*

Life questions: How does Jesus' death on the cross for your sins impact your life? What does living sacrificially for Christ mean and how can I live it out? Abraham was ready to sacrifice his son, Isaac, but God provided a ram. The priests were required to make sacrifices for the sins of the people. These were foreshadowing of the sacrifice God provided in Jesus' death on the cross for the sins of humankind. We must live sacrificially for Christ.

Day 2 - Matchless Forgiveness THE GRAND NARRATIVE - JOSEPH AND JESUS

Scripture: *Genesis 37:3-4, 18-28; 39:1-6; 41:46-49, 53-57; 42:1-26; 45:1-14, John 20:1-18*

Life questions: When were you reconciled to God through Christ, receiving forgiveness for your sins? Who do you know who needs the forgiveness of Christ in his or her life? Joseph was abandoned and sold into slavery by his brothers but God used that to provide for His people and worked through Joseph to show forgiveness to his brothers. Jesus came to earth to bring forgiveness. Through His resurrection from the dead, Jesus reconciled us to the Father, covering our sin and redeeming us so that we can have a relationship with the Father. We must accept the forgiveness of Christ and be willing to forgive ourselves and others.



THEME OVERVIEW - MATCHLESS ONE

Day 3 - Matchless Obedience THE GRAND NARRATIVE - ABRAHAM AND JESUS

Scripture: *Genesis 11:31-12:1-9, Genesis 15:1-21, Luke 4:1-13*

Life Questions: How have you been obedient to God's leading in your life? How can you remain faithful to Him in the future? Abraham followed God's plan and left his life as he knew it to relocate his family to Canaan. Even though Abraham was old with no children, because of his obedience, God established a covenant with him that his descendants would become a great nation. Jesus was obedient to God's leading in His life. When Satan tempted Him in the desert, He remained true to God. And, He resolved to live a perfect life on earth, to die on the cross and be raised again for the salvation of all mankind. We must be obedient and remain faithful to God's working in our lives.

Day 4 - Matchless Risk THE GRAND NARRATIVE – ESTHER AND JESUS

Scripture: *Esther 2:5-10, 15-18; 5:1-8; 8:1-13, Luke 4:31-36, Luke 19:45-48*

Life questions: What does taking a risk for Christ look like? How can you muster the courage to act when the situation is risky? Out of boldness and courage, Esther was willing to take risks for her people, the Jews, by becoming Queen and approaching the King on behalf of her people. Jesus went against the status quo, tradition, and the religious leaders in order to spread the gospel. We must take risks to share and live out Christ.
