Scripture: Psalm 51

How to PRAY? -

- 1. Praise
- 2. Repent
- 3. Ask
- 4. Yield

What Hinders Prayer?

- 1. A lack of desire and effort to pray with people.
- 2. A lack of desire and effort to pray at all.
- 3. A broken fellowship with God due to unconfessed sin.
- 4. A relationship with God that never started.

Nothing helps prayer more than acknowledging and confessing sin and acknowledging and confessing the gospel:

- We are born sinners to sinners. (v. 5)
- There is a moment of salvation that we respond to. (vs. 10-12)
- When we sin, we confess it before God and to trusted brothers or sisters. (vs. 1, 4)
- We need ongoing repentance, restoration, and renewal from the Lord. (vs. 2-3, 7-10)
- The purpose of repentance, restoration, and renewal is to teach sinners to come to Christ. (vs. 13-15)
- The result of repentance is unhindered prayer with the Triune God.
