Scripture: Psalm 67

How to PRAY? -

1. Praise
2. Repent
3. Ask
4. Yield

What Hinders Prayer?

1. A lack of desire and effort to pray with people.
2. A lack of desire and effort to pray at all.
3. A broken fellowship with God due to unconfessed sin.
4. A relationship with God that never started.

What Do I Pray For? Psalm 67

May God be gracious to us and bless us and make His face to shine upon us, Selah
2 that Your way may be known on earth, Your saving power among all nations.
3 Let the peoples praise You, O God; let all the peoples praise You!
4 Let the nations be glad and sing for joy, for You judge the peoples with equity
and guide the nations upon earth. Selah
5 Let the peoples praise You, O God; let all the peoples praise You!
6 The earth has yielded its increase; God, our God, shall bless us.
7 God shall bless us; let all the ends of the earth fear Him!

10 Things God tells us to pray for:

1. Pray for God's grace to be upon us. (v. 1)
 - a. Grace to be believed by us and revealed through us.
2. Pray for God's blessing to be upon us. (vs. 1, 7) (Luke 11:9-13)
 - a. When we ask for a blessing, God gives us the Holy Spirit.
3. Pray for God's glory to be upon us. (v. 1)
 - a. Glory revealed to us and through us.
 - b. In sickness and in health (James 5:14)
4. Pray for God's gospel to be spoken boldly by us. (v. 2) (Acts 4:29)
 - a. God's gospel to be known by us and made known through us.
5. Pray for God to save many different peoples. (v. 2)
6. Pray for God's people to praise Him. (vs. 3, 5)
7. Pray for revival among the nations. (v. 4)
8. Pray for God's will to be done on earth as it is in heaven. (v. 4) (Matt. 6:10)
9. Pray for harvest workers to be sent by the church. (vs. 5-6) (Luke 10:2)
10. Pray for the fear of the Lord to be the measure of our lives. (v. 7)
