How do I pray with power? Psalm 105

- 1. Pray in the name of Christ continually. (Psalm 105:1, 1 Thess. 5:16-18)
 - God has a conditional will and unconditional will. (Will vs. Plans)
 - o **James 4:2c** You do not have, because you do not ask.
 - o Isaiah 65:24 Before they call I will answer; while they are yet speaking I will hear.
 - Prayer accesses power in pain.
 - James 5:13 Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful?
 Let him sing praise.
- 2. Praise the name of Christ continually. (Psalm 105:2-3)
- 3. Proclaim the name of Christ continually. (Psalm 105:2-3)
- 4. <u>Seek</u> the presence of Christ continually. (Psalm 105:4-5, Mark 11:24-25; James 1:5-8, Romans 10:17)
 - Believing what God says in His Word is faith.
- 5. Speak the Word of Christ continually. (Psalm 105:5, James 5:16-18; 1 Kings 18:41-46)
 - Pray with your Bible open!
 - Praying in God's power will change your circumstance.
 - Praying in God's power will change you.
