When We Share the Good News of Jesus:

1. **Expect Opposition (from outside and inside the fellowship).**
2. **Expect God to Move.**

When Opposition Comes

1. Don't let False Accusations make you lose your witness. (Acts 24:1-9)

Isaiah 53:7-9 ESV

2. When accusations come, give faithful answers and point people to Jesus. (Acts 24:10-21)

3. When you find yourself in impossible situations (situations beyond your control) - faithfully share Jesus. (Keep looking up). (Acts 24:22-27)

Paul shared Jesus with Felix:

- You must do something with yesterday's sin. (righteousness)
- You must do something with today's temptations. (Self control)
- You must do something about the judgment to come. (God's Return)
