**Title: Protector**

**Psalm 32:7; Exodus 1:22; Exodus 2**

**1. Father God protects His children from Satan. (Exodus 1:22; 2:1-10)**

- **John 10:10 - *The thief comes to steal, kill, and destroy...***
- **God uses every resource to protect His children:**
  - His people
  - our faith
  - the lost

**2. Father God protects His children from self. (Exodus 2:11-15)**

**Prov. 5:21** *For a man’s ways are before the eyes of the Lord, and he ponders all his paths.*

**3. Father God protects His children in sin. (Exodus 3:16-22)**

- **God goes before us when we are running away in our sin.**
- **God gives us good gifts that we do not deserve to protect us from destruction.**
- **God teaches us His mercy and grace as we repent from our sin.**

**Psalm 90:12-17**

**4. Father God protects His children in suffering. (Exodus 2:23-25)**

- Our Father hears us.
- Our Father remembers His promises.
- Our Father knows what to do.
- Our Father acts for His glory and our good.

**Fathers are called to be like our Father God for our families to teach them to know and trust Him!**

- Fathers hear their families.
- Fathers remember their promises and the promises of the Father.
- Fathers know to look to Christ when they know what to do and when they don't know what to do.
- Fathers act for God's glory and the good of their families.
