**Title: Authority Scripture: Exodus 19-20** 

- 1. God our Father deserves to be our authority. (19:3-4)
  - He rescues us.
  - He redeems us.
  - He restores us.
- 2. God our Father describes why He is our authority. (19:5-9)
  - The earth belongs to our Father.
  - We belong to our Father.
    - We are His treasured possession.
    - We are a kingdom of priests.
    - We are a holy nation.
  - Our Father engages us as our authority.
    - He comes to us. (We meet Him.)
    - He speaks to us. (We hear Him.)
    - He reveals to us. (We believe and receive Him.)
- 3.God our Father demands we submit to His authority. (19:2, 9-25)
  - God our Father is Holy.
  - God our Father prepares His sinful children for His coming.
  - God our Father's coming is sure and is awe inspiring
    - Luke 1:35 the Advent of Jesus, 1st Coming of Jesus
    - Luke 2:9 the announcement of His coming



## 4. God our Father commands us to live in freedom and power as our authority. (Exodus 20)

- Believe the gospel. (20:1-2)
  - God frees us from slavery to sin by His grace.
  - o God gives us new life in Christ.
  - God calls us to live for His glory by obeying His Word.
- Love God. (20:3-8)
- Love people. (20:9-21)

\*We can only love God and love people if we submit to Christ in salvation and are empowered by the Holy Spirit.

## **10 Commandments for Freedom and Power**

- 1. Love God Father God is our authority. He tells us who to worship.
- 2. Sanctity of Worship He tells us how to worship.
- 3. Sanctity of God's Name
- 4. Sanctity of Rest (Col. 2:16-17)
- 5. Love people Sanctity of Parenthood
- 6. Sanctity of **Life**
- 7. Sanctity of Marriage
- 8. Sanctity of **Generosity**
- 9. Sanctity of **Speech/Truth**
- 10. Sanctity of **Contentment**

## The Ten Commandments Affirmed in the New Testament:

- 1. Have no other gods before Me (Acts 14:15; John 4:21–23; 1 Tim. 2:5; James 2:19; 1 Cor. 8:6).
- 2. Make no idols or images (Acts 17:29; Rom. 1:22–23; 1 John 5:21; 1 Cor. 10:7, 14).
- 3. Do not take His name in vain (James 5:12; Matt. 5:33–37 and 6:5–9).
- 4. Remember the Sabbath Day (Matt. 11:25-30; Col. 2:16-17).
- 5. Honor father and mother (Eph. 6:1–4).
- 6. Do not murder (1 John 3:15; Matt. 5:21–22).
- 7. Do not commit adultery (Matt. 5:27–28; 1 Cor. 5:1–13, 6:9–20; Heb. 13:4).
- 8. Do not steal (Eph. 4:28; 2 Thes. 3:10–12; James 5:1–4).
- 9. Do not bear false witness (Col. 3:9; Eph. 4:25).
- 10. Do not covet (Eph. 5:3; Luke 12:15-21).
