Title: Jesus is Better than Drifting Scripture: Hebrews 2:1-4

One positive affirmation:

1. Pay close attention to the Word of God proclaimed to you.

Two Words of Warning:

1. Beware of drifting in life.
 - a. What are the current cultural currents that pull drifters away:
 - i. The current of social media.
 - ii. The current of success.
 - iii. The current of schedules.
 - iv. The current of social lives.
 - v. The current of situational ethics.
 - vi. The current of sacrifice.
2. Beware of neglecting salvation. Here's how you attend to salvation:
 - a. Respond to the invitation from the Lord.
 - b. Gather, group, grow, and go.
 - c. Selflessly serve and sacrificially share the good news.

Three benefits given to us for the journey of life:

1. The declaration of salvation by the Lord.
2. The testimony of those who have heard, believed, and been saved.
3. The witness of God's work and gifts in and through the church.

Small Groups in January: Evangelism Methods and Strategies

Gospel memory Verse 1: Romans 6:23 *"For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."* (All people have an unsolvable sin problem.)

Gospel memory Verse 2: John 3:16-18 *16 "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. 17 For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through Him. 18 Whoever believes in Him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God."* (Jesus is God's loving solution.)

Gospel memory Verse 3: Acts 3:19 *"Repent therefore, and turn back, that your sins may be blotted out"* (Repent; turn from sin to God's forgiveness)

Gospel memory Verse 4: Romans 10:9 *"If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved."* (Believe and confess Jesus as your Lord)

Gospel memory Verse 5: Ephesians 2:8-10 *"8 For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, 9 not a result of works, so that no one may boast. 10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them."* (Faith by grace alone)

Gospel memory Verse 6: 2 Corinthians 5:17 *"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come."* (New Life)

Gospel memory Verse 7: John 14:3 *"And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to Myself, that where I am you may be also."* (Eternal Life)
