**Title: Jesus is Better than Life and Death Scripture: Hebrews 2:1-18**

**Jesus is better than life and death because:**

- 1. Jesus is the Sovereign Suffering Servant King**
  - a. Who engages His people.**
  - b. Who empowers His people.**
  - **So we should submit to the King.**
  
- 2. Jesus is the captain of salvation**
  - a. Who suffered and sanctifies.**
  - b. Who opens the only way for others to follow.**
  - **So we should surrender to salvation.**
  
- 3. Jesus is the best big brother**
  - a. Who conquered death for His younger brothers and sisters.**
  - b. Who conquered the devil for His younger brothers and sisters.**
  - c. Who conquers the fear of death for His younger brothers and sisters.**
  - **So we should shelter with our brother.**
  
- 4. Jesus is the merciful and faithful high priest**
  - a. Who makes propitiation for His people.**
  - **So we should serve with our High Priest.**

**Small Groups in January: Evangelism Methods and Strategies**

**Gospel memory Verse 1: Romans 6:23** *“For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”* (All people have an unsolvable sin problem.)

**Gospel memory Verse 2: John 3:16-18** *16 “For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. 17 For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through Him. 18 Whoever believes in Him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.”* (Jesus is God’s loving solution.)

**Gospel memory Verse 3: Acts 3:19** *“Repent therefore, and turn back, that your sins may be blotted out”* (Repent; turn from sin to God’s forgiveness)

**Gospel memory Verse 4: Romans 10:9** *“If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.”* (Believe and confess Jesus as your Lord)

**Gospel memory Verse 5: Ephesians 2:8-10** *“8 For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, 9 not a result of works, so that no one may boast. 10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.”* (Faith by grace alone)

**Gospel memory Verse 6: 2 Corinthians 5:17** *“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.”* (New Life)

**Gospel memory Verse 7: John 14:3** *“And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to Myself, that where I am you may be also.”* (Eternal Life)
