Jesus Guarantees with Better credentials. (vs. 11-13)

• **Guarantor Definition:** A guarantor is a financial term describing an individual who promises to pay a borrower's debt in the event that the borrower defaults on their loan obligation. Guarantors pledge their own assets as collateral against the loans. (Philippians 3:3-9)

Jesus guarantees a better covenant with a better hope. (vs. 14-22)

- The Old Covenant/Mosaic Covenant
 - Conditional covenant
 - Required adherence to the Law
 - Was a placeholder foreshadowing Christ
- The New Covenant
 - Unconditional covenant
 - Jesus is the guarantor
 - Jesus gives us hope

Jesus guarantees with unlimited Credit. (2 Cor 8:9, Eph 1:3-10, 13-14)
