Scripture: Psalm 23

- 1. Praise Jesus for being your personal Lord and Savior. (Psalm 23:1)
- 2. Praise Jesus for satisfying your daily needs and desires. (Psalm 23:1-3)
 - a. He personally guides you to nourishment. (His NAME is at stake.)
 - b. He personally leads you in righteousness. (His GLORY is at stake.)
- 3. Praise Jesus for walking through the valleys of life and death. (Psalm 23:4)
 - Fear is a choice: so is faith.
 - a. Jesus provides courage in fear.
 - b. Jesus provides comfort in loss.
 - c. Jesus provides confidence in death.
 - d. Jesus provides care in pain.
 - o John 10:7-15, 27
- 4. Praise Jesus for providing your protection & healing. (Psalm 23:5)
 - a. We rest in His protection and we consume His Word.
- 5. Praise Jesus for giving you unconditional love & a home. (Psalm 23:6)
 - Pray surrender to God's goodness and mercy.

The Name of God reflects the lines of Psalm 23.

- "I shall not want" **Jehovah-Jireh**, the Lord will provide (Gen. 22:14)
- "Still waters" **Jehovah-Shalom**, The Lord our peace (Judges 6:24)
- "Restores my soul" **Jehovah-Rophe**, The Lord who heals (Ex. 15:26)
- "Paths of Righteousness" *Jehovah-Tsidkenu*, The Lord our righteousness (Jer. 33:16)
- "You are with me" **Jehovah-Shammah**, The Lord is there (Ezek. 48:35)
- "Presence of my enemies" **Jehovah-Nissi**, The Lord our Banner (Ex. 17:15)
- "Anoint my head" Jehovah-M'Kaddesh, The Lord who sanctifies (Lev. 20:8)
