Title: Praying Through Shame

- 1. We surrender to and trust in God. (Psalm 25:1-2, 20), Romans 5:1-5
- 2. We wait on (serve) and follow Christ. (Psalm 25:3-5, 21), 1 Cor. 15:34, & 2 Thess. 3:14 It is not hateful to pray that people who do not trust in God be disappointed by what they are trusting in. It is hateful to allow them to continue to trust in something that will shame them without interceding for them in prayer.
- 3. We experience God's tender mercies and eternal goodness. (Psalm 25:6-8)
- 4. We are forgiven and loved by Father God. (Psalm 25:7, 11, 18)
- 5. We fear the Lord and humble ourselves before Him. (Psalm 25:9, 12-14)
- 6. We pursue the Lord and keep His Word. (Psalm 25:10, 4-5)
- 7. We don't turn away from the Lord when trouble comes. We let God handle our troubles and troublers. (Psalm 25:15-22)
