Title: Praying Through Sin

Scripture: Psalm 32

Ephesians 1:7: *In him (Christ) we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace,*

2 Cor 5:19: *that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. 20 Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. 21 For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.*

1. **All sin is covered by the blood of Jesus. (Psalm 32:1-2)**
2. **Hiding sin eats away at you. (Psalm 32:3-4)**
 - **Hidden sin does more damage to you and others than the sin itself.**
3. **Confessing sin enables you to experience the forgiveness the Lord paid for. (Psalm 32:5-6)**
4. **God shields us from the haters when we confess our sin to God and trusted brothers and sisters. (Psalm 32:7)**
5. **God restores us to right relationships with Him and others when we confess. (Psalm 32:8)**
6. **God's constant love helps us wade through the sorrows of those who refuse to trust the Lord. (Psalm 32:9-10)**
7. **Expressing gladness and joy in the Lord comes from knowing our sin is covered. (Psalm 32:11)**
