Scripture: Hebrews 11:1-6

Hebrews 10:35 <u>Therefore do not throw away your confidence</u>, which has a great reward. 36 <u>For you have need of endurance</u>, so that when you have done the will of God you may receive what is promised. 37 For, "Yet a little while, and the coming one will come and will not delay; 38 <u>but my righteous one shall live by faith</u>, and if he shrinks back, my soul has no pleasure in him." 39 But <u>we are not of those who shrink back</u> and are destroyed, but of those who have faith and preserve their souls

Read Hebrews 11:1-40

## What faith is NOT:

- Saving faith is not faith for faith's sake.
  - o It is not blind optimism (Somewhere over the rainbow).
  - It is not conjured up feelings (The sun will come out tomorrow).
  - It is not feelings divorced from GOSPEL TRUTH.

## 1 John 2:22-26

- Saving faith is not believing without evidence (superstition).
  - It is not a leap in the dark.
  - It is not accepting something to be true apart from the evidence.
  - o It is not "I believe" because "I believe."
- Saving faith is not positive thinking.
  - It is not faith in yourself.
  - o It is not faith in your job.
  - o It is not pumping yourself up.

Saving Faith starts with GOD, the object of faith. Romans 5:1-2

What faith is: (Heb. 11:1-6)

Saving faith is active dependence on what can be known about God through Christ.

1. Faith starts with knowledge of God. (11:3, John 17:3) HOW?!

God shows Himself in creation. God shows Himself in the Bible. God shows Himself in Jesus.

- 2. Faith continues in assent to and belief in gospel truth. (11:1, 1 John 5:1-5, James 2:19)
- 3. Faith is sealed in trusting and acting on that gospel truth. (11:2, 4-6, Matt. 11:28-29)

## What faith causes:

- Commendation from the Lord
- Believers to draw near to God
