Scripture: Hebrews 12:1-3

- Adam was rested in the Garden. (Gen 2:15)
- God supplied the good in the Garden. (Gen 2:21)
- Man sought his own good. (Gen 3:6)
- Shame came in the fall. (Gen 3:7)

- Fix your eyes on Jesus. (Heb 12:2)
- Fix your thoughts on Jesus. (Heb 3:1)
- Fix your eyes on the cross.
- Jesus scorned the shame of the Cross. (Heb 12:2)
- Adam sinned in the garden; Jesus was arrested in the garden. (Gen 3 & Matt 26:50)
- Adam hid in the garden; Jesus prayed in the garden. (Gen 3:8 & Matt 26:36-39)
- Adam was naked in the Garden; Jesus was naked on the cross. (Gen 3:7,10 & Jn 19:23)
- Thorns in the garden remind us of the fall. Jesus wore the reminder. (Gen 3:18 & Matt 27:29)
- The good tree became an instrument of death; Jesus was nailed to a tree (Gen 2:17, Gal 3:13)
- From Jesus side came the bride. (Gen 2:21-22 & Jn 19:34)

- Jesus is the Last Adam. (1 Cor 15:45)
- Jesus endured for the joy set before Him. (Heb 12:2)

 - To manifest His glory. (Heb 1:3-4)
- Jesus is a Better Hope. (Heb 12:3)
